Group One : Std 5 to 7 - Select Any One Topic

Group Two : Std 8 to 10 – Select Any One Topic

- 3) Stories on Universal Brotherhood - विश्व बन्धुत्व पर आधारित नाटक

Time : 10 a.m. (Group One) and 2:30 p.m. (Group Two)

Time Limit : 15 Minutes only, including introduction of play (Strictly to be followed)

RULES OF THE ELOCUTION COMPETITION:

1. The participant must report 15 mins before at the venue for the registration.
2. All the students will be given a Participation Certificate.
3. The language of Nukkad Natak Competition is HINDI only.
4. The School Hindi teacher can help students in writing the Natak based on topics mentioned group wise. No duplication of stories/ topics by school especially Topic 1 in both groups.
5. Time limit has to be followed strictly by the students. After 12 mins one warning bell will be given, which means in 3 mins they need to finished the skit. Exceeding TIME LIMIT it will add negative marks to the group. Each Nukkad Natak can have maximum 4 participants.
6. The Entries for the competition must be emailed to jremaha@gmail.com. Mentioning details Story Title, Participants Full Name, Std, Age, Parent Mobile Number and School Name.
7. The participants will not be allowed to read script from any paper during performance. The participants must carry their own makeup, props, and costumes for their Natak.
8. The performance area – THE STAGE will be in centre surrounded by the public.
9. Refreshments will be served to the participants only.
10. Decisions of the Judges and the Committee will be final.
