Dear Parents,

The Chief Guest for the Seventy Third Annual Athletic Meet will be Ms. Sanaya Anklesaria (Previous Captain of the Maharashtra Football Team, Previous Coach of the Maharashtra State Football Team and Current Coach of the Youth Team of the Mumbai City Football Club) and Mr. & Mrs. Nakra, proud parents of our Head Prefect, Tia Nakra shall be the Guests of Honour.

Attendance is compulsory for all students of Stds. I to IX

Please note the following:

1. REPORTING TIME:

All the participants in the March Past, the Band, Judo, Guides and the various events need to report at the grounds at 8:15 a.m. sharp. Non-participating students should also be in their seats latest by 8:30 a.m.

Pre-Primary students if they wish to attend have to be compulsorily accompanied by any one parent.

Parents and well-wishers who wish to view the Annual Athletic Meet may do so.

2. DRESS CODE:

- a. The <u>participants in the March Past</u> must wear clean P.T. uniforms, caps, clean polished black (two-velcro) shoes and ankle length socks. Hair should be tied with black rubber bands in two plaits.
- b. The Band children must wear their complete Band Uniform.
- c. Participants of the various races will wear their respective clean house T-shirts with comfortable and decent shorts, track pants etc. Participants can wear their school shoes, spikes, or any other comfortable sports shoes.

 Running without shoes on the track is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate disqualification.
- d. Non-participants in the stands should wear a neat and clean P.T. school uniform only. Every child must wear socks and polished black school shoes only.

3. <u>SEATING ARRANGEMENT</u>:

All the students, participants, as well as non-participants, should be seated **House-wise** in the stands. They are allowed to cheer the children of their respective houses in a dignified manner. There is a separate seating area for parents, P.T.A. and well-wishers. Children are not allowed to sit with their parents except the Pre-Primary Students.

5. <u>DISCIPLINE</u>:

Perfect discipline must be maintained throughout the Meet.

- a) Students, under no circumstances, will walk across the tracks or in front of the Guests at any given time. After their event, they must use the small gate to enter the seating area in the stadium.
- b) Children should wear their caps and bring their own water-bottles. No child will litter the grounds. All the wrappers, etc. should be disposed off in the dust-bins kept at convenient spots in the University Ground or should be taken home.
- c) Children must remain seated on the Stands and not move about while the events are going on under any circumstances. Children should not come down to the tracks to cheer for their friends. If they do so, marks will be deducted from their House scores and the concerned child will be dealt with accordingly. The Captains and Vice Captains should assist the teachers in—charge to maintain discipline in the stands.
- d) Perfect silence should be maintained at the time of flag hoisting, oath taking ceremony, lowering of the flag and National Anthem as these are solemn moments.
- e) There should be absolutely no movement when the Chief Guest and Guests of Honour are being introduced and when they speak, as it adversely reflects upon the high standard of discipline maintained by The Alexandra Girls' English Institution.

NO CHILD OR PARENT WILL BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE TILL THE NATIONAL ANTHEM IS PLAYED AT THE END OF THE MEET.

Parents are requested to attend in large numbers, to motivate our young athletes. Please encourage ex-students too, to attend the Athletic Meet.
