The Competitions will be held in two age groups on two different dates: i.e.

Group One : Std 5 to 7 on Saturday, 24th August 2024

Group Two : Std 8 to 10 on Saturday, 31st August 2024

- 2) Lack of Indian Culture among youth
- 3) Influence of Social Media on youth
- 4) Impact of Artificial Intelligence on Jobs

Only TWO students per Group per School will be allowed

Prizes : Three Prizes will be awarded in each group
Cash Prizes- First Prize: Rs. 1000/- , Second Prize: Rs. 700/- and
Third Prize: Rs. 500/- along with Merit Certificate.

Time : 10 a.m. on both the competition dates

Time Limit : 5 Minutes only (Strictly to be followed)

Entry Fees : Rs. 100/- per student should be paid on the day competition

Last Date of Entries: Thursday, 22nd August 2024
(Overall First 60 Entries will be accepted)

RULES OF THE ELOCUTION COMPETITION:

1. The participant must report 15 mins before at the venue in school uniform only for the registration.
2. All the students will be given a Participation Certificate.
3. The language of Elocution is ENGLISH only.
4. Every participant should submit his / her written Elocution Essay on the same day of the competition at the registration desk typed or well written manually on a foolscap paper with their details on it (refer to point 6) (Hard Copy). The schools must inform this to participating students well in advance. (Compulsory)
5. Time limit has to be followed strictly by the students. Exceeding time limit for the competition will be given negative marks after the bell.
6. The Entries for the competition must be emailed to jrcmaha@gmail.com. Mentioning details Participants Name, Topic Selected, Std, Age, Mobile Number and School Name.
7. The students can prepare and speak on any one topic given as per their group. Participants will not be allowed to read from any paper.
8. Decision of the Judges and the Committee shall be final. No entries after due date and same day of the competition will be entertained.
9. Refreshments will be served to the participant only.
