The Competitions will be held in Four categories i.e.

Group One

: Std III to IV

Group Two

: Std V to VII

Group Three : Std VIII to X

Group Four : Std XI & XII

Prizes

: Three Prizes will be awarded in each group

Entry Fees

: Rs. 60/- per head

RULES OF THE RAKHI MAKING COMPETITION:

1. All the rakhi making materials should be brought by the participants for the competition.

2. Readymade rakhi is disqualified from the competition. No Rakhis to be prepared of flowers, food grains or eatable materials i.e biscuits, chocolates, candy, gems, rice, pulses, dal etc. No glitters and sparkles are allowed.

3. Only ONE Rakhi is allowed per student.

- 4. The rakhi must be prepared on the spot, under the supervision of the Junior Red Cross Authorities.
- 5. The students should be accompanied by their school teacher compulsory.
- Parents won't be allowed to enter inside the venue school premises.

All students must come in school uniform.

8. The participating schools has to inform and mail us the students details before 14th August for us to make the necessary arrangements. (No walk in entry will be considered during the day of the competition)

9. The students must report 15 mins early before the competition at the venue.

LAST DATE FOR RECEIVING ENTRIES: Wednesday, 14th August 2024

PLEASE NOTE: ON THE SPOT ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.

Only 50 entries per groups can be accepted. The entries can be either email on jrcmaha@gmail.com or admin@jrcmum.org before 14th August. The hardcopy of the student list updated (Xerox set) along with entry fees can be paid at the venue of the competition to the Junior Red Cross Authorities by the teacher in charge only.
